

# RESORT VILLAGE OF WEE TOO BEACH

## BYLAW NO. 3/2005

### A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS

The Council of the Resort Village of Wee Too Beach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:



1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
  - (a) "administrator" shall mean the administrator of the resort village;
  - (b) "running at large" shall mean when the dog is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner
  - © "first time violator" shall mean the first violation of this bylaw.
2. All dogs that are beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner are to be secured by a leash.
3. Any owner of a dog who contravenes section 2 more than once shall be liable to a penalty of \$20.00
  - (a) first time violators will be issued a written warning
  - (b) a repeating violator of this bylaw, upon being served with a "Notice of Violation" can voluntarily make payment to the administrator.
  - (c) any unpaid "notice of violations" will be tallied at the end of the current year issued and added to the owner's following year's tax levy.
  - (d) the "Notice of Violation" shall be in form "1" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
