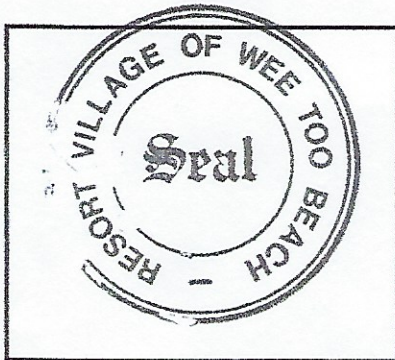
**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PERMITTED USES OF ROAD ALLOWANCES
AND PUBLIC RESERVE LANDS**

The Council of the Resort Village of Wee Too Beach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1 No person shall erect any permanent or temporary structure, including fences on any portion of road allowance or public reserves without the expressed written approval of Council.
- 2 No person shall store any personal property or property of others on any portion or road allowance or public reserves without the expressed written approval of Council.
- 3 No person shall alter the land on any road allowance or public reserve including grading, planting or removal of any trees, shrubs or grass without the expressed written approval of Council.
- 4 No person shall cause an obstruction on any road allowance or public reserve that may interfere with snow removal, general maintenance or safety.
- 5 No existing structure shall be "Grandfathered" by this bylaw.
