COVID-19

On Monday, June 8th, the Province released guidelines for the continuing Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan. Council has met and discussed how they can meet the requirements set out by the Province for beaches, outdoor parks and playgrounds. Council wishes to advise that the playgrounds, parks and beaches will not be maintained and will continue to be closed. Anyone using the areas are doing so at their own risk. With the current approved budget and staffing, Council does not have the ability to permit the opening of unstaffed, unsupervised outdoor areas. The portapotties will continue to be closed due to the inability to maintain required cleaning/sanitation and no staff is available to do so with required cleaning, disinfection and PPE protocols set out by the Province.

Council thanks everyone for their cooperation in physically distancing, hand washing and staying home if you are ill. As we do not have control over who attends our beaches, parks and play areas, please continue to protect yourself, supervise your children and help keep COVID-19 away from others.
